This week the Central Bank of Kenya offered 91 day Treasury Bills for a total of Kshs 4 Billion. The total number of bids received was 197 amounting to Kshs. 9.68 Billion, representing a subscription of 242 %. Total bids accepted amounted to Kshs 4.5 Billion. The market weighted average rate was 9.445%, and the weighted average of accepted bids which will be applied for non-competitive bids was 8.583% down from 10.267% in the previous auction.
