This week the Central Bank of Kenya offered 182 day Treasury Bills for a total of Kshs 3 Billion. The total number of bids received was 198 amounting to Kshs 6.1 Billion, representing a subscription of 203%. Bids accepted amounted to Ksh. 6.0 Billion. The market weighted average rate was 18.771% while the weighted average rate of accepted bids, which will be applied for non-competitive bids was 18.757% down from 19.247% recorded in the previous auction.
