

A. RESULTS OF FIVE AND TWENTY YEAR TREASURY BONDS ISSUE NOS. FXD 2/2016/5 & FXD 1/2008/20 DATED 25/07/2016

This month the Central Bank of Kenya offered 5-year and 20-year Treasury Bonds for a total amount of Kshs 30 Billion. The total number of bids received was 739 amounting to Kshs 26.15 Billion and 642 amounting to Kshs 14.72 Billion for the 5-year and 20-year bond respectively. The weighted average rate for successful bids was 14.069% for the 5-year Bond and 14.836% for the 20-year Bond. The other auction statistics are summarised in the table below.
