RESULTS OF 91 DAYS TREASURY BILLS ISSUE NO. 2001 VALUE DATED
29/04/2013
This week the Central Bank of Kenya offered 91 -day Treasury Bills for a total of Kshs. 3 Billion. The total number of bids received was 249 amounting to Kshs.2.92 Billion, representing a subscription of $97 \%$. Total bids accepted amounted to Kshs.2.92 Billion. The market weighted average rate was $10.206 \%$, and the weighted average of accepted bids which will be applied for non-competitive bids was $10.206 \%$ down from $10.258 \%$ in the previous auction. The other auction statistics are summarised in the table below.

The Central Bank reserves the right to accept/reject bids in part or in full without giving any reason. Individual bids must be of a minimum face value of Kshs. 100,000.00. Only CDS holders with updated mandates are eligible.

Bids must be submitted using the specified format and must reach the Central Bank (HQ, Branch or Currency Centre) by 2.00 p.m. on Thursday 2nd May 2013 for 91 -day, 182 -day and 364 -day Treasury Bills. Payments above Kshs. 1 Million must be made by electronic tranfer using RTGS. Payments below Kshs. 1 Million may be made by Banker's Cheque or RTGS. These payments must reach the Central Bank not later than Monday 6th May 20132.00 p.m. for Cheques and 3.00 p.m for RTGS electronic fund transfers. Please provide the following details with each payment: Name, Reference No., the New CDS Portfolio and the customer's Virtual account No.
D. NON-COMPETITIVE BIDS

Non-competitive bids are subject to a maximum of Kshs. 20 Million per investor and are issued at the weighted average of accepted bids.
