This week the Central Bank of Kenya offered 91-day Treasury Bills for a total of Kshs.1 Billion. The total number of bids received was 147 amounting to Kshs.2.81 Billion, representing a subscription of 281%. Total bids accepted amounted to Kshs.2.41 Billion. The market weighted average rate was 8.481%, and the weighted average of accepted bids which will be applied for non-competitive bids was 8.453% down from 8.463% in the previous auction.
