

A. RESULTS OF 15-YEAR TREASURY BOND ISSUE NO. IFB 1/2016/15 DATED 24/10/2016

Central Bank of Kenya offered a 5-year Treasury Bond for a total amount of Kshs 30 Billion. The total number of bids received was 1268 amounting to Kshs 35.09 Billion. The weighted average rate for successful bids was 13.177%. The other auction statistics are summarised in the table below.
