

A. RESULTS OF 10-YEAR TREASURY BOND ISSUE NO. FXD 1/2016/10 DATED 29/08/2016

Central Bank of Kenya offered a 10-year Treasury Bond for a total amount of Kshs 25 Billion. The total number of bids received was 795 amounting to Kshs 26.31 Billion. The weighted average rate for successful bids was 15.039%. The other auction statistics are summarised in the table below.
