



**A. RESULTS OF 182 DAYS TREASURY BILLS ISSUE NO. 1908 VALUE DATED**

**28/11/2011**

This week the Central Bank of Kenya offered 182 day Treasury Bills for a total of Kshs 3 Billion. The total number of bids received was 38 amounting to Kshs 680 Million, representing a subscription of 23%. Consequently, the weighted average rate of accepted bids, which will be applied for non-competitive rose to 16.471% from 15.738% recorded in the previous auction. The other auction statistics are summarised in the table below.

Only CDS holders with updated mandates are eligible.

Bids must be submitted using the specified format and must reach the Central Bank (HQ, Branch or Currency Centre) by 2.00 p.m. on Wednesday 30th November 2011 for 182 Day and Thursday 01st December 2011 for 91 Day Treasury Bills. Payments above Kshs.1 Million must be made by electronic transfer using RTGS. Payments below Kshs. 1 Million may be made by Banker's Cheque or RTGS and must reach the Central Bank not later than 2.00 p.m. on Monday 05th December 2011 for Cheques and 3.00 p.m for RTGS electronic fund transfers. Please provide the following details with each payment: Name, Reference No., CDS account No., and include 'Government Treasury Bills Suspense A/c no. 01-070-0001' when using RTGS.

**D. NON-COMPETITIVE BIDS**

Non-competitive bids are subject to a maximum of Kshs. 20 Million per investor and are issued at the weighted average of accepted bids.
