- b) Correct wording for Section A item 9 on consent to read: from Acting Director, Department of Procurement and Logistics Services.
- c) Correct wording for Section B item 4 on consent to read: from Acting Director, Department of Procurement and Logistics Services.
- d) **No.** There will be full load testing at the site at installation stage.
