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A. RESULTS OF 91 DAYS TREASURY BILLS ISSUE NO. 2161 VALUE DATED

23/05/2016

This week the Central Bank of Kenya offered 91-day Treasury Bills for a total of Kshs.4 Billion. The total number of bids received was 216 amounting to Kshs 7.29 Billion, representing a subscription of 182.19%. Total bids accepted amounted to Kshs 4.80 Billion. The market weighted average rate was 8.049%, and the weighted average of accepted bids which will be applied for non-competitive bids was 7.998% down from 8.189% in the previous auction. The other auction statistics are summarised in the table below.

Where several successful bidders quote a common rate, the Central Bank of Kenya reserves the right to allot bids on a pro-rata basis. The Central Bank reserves the right to accept/reject bids in part or in full without giving any reason. Individual bids must be of a minimum face value of Kshs. 100,000.00. Only investors with active CDS accounts are eligible.

Bids must be submitted using the specified format and must reach the Central Bank (HQ, Branch or Currency Centre) by 2.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 25th May, 2016 for 182-day and 364-day and Thursday 26th May, 2016 for 91-day Treasury Bills. Payments above Kshs.1 Million must be made by electronic transfer using RTGS. Payments below Kshs.1 Million may be made by Cash, Banker's Cheque or RTGS. These payments must reach the Central Bank not later than Monday, 30th May 2016, 2.00 p.m. for Cash and Cheques and 3.00 p.m for RTGS electronic fund transfers. Please provide the following details with each payment: Name, Reference No., CDS Portfolio No. and the customer's Virtual account No.

E. Non-competitive bids are subject to a maximum of Kshs. 20 Million per investor and are issued at the weighted average of accepted bids.
