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A. RESULTS OF 91 DAYS TREASURY BILLS ISSUE NO. 2051 VALUE DATED 14/04/2014

This week the Central Bank of Kenya offered 91-day Treasury Bills for a total of Kshs. 3 Billion. The total number of bids received was 162 amounting to Kshs. 1.21 Billion, representing a subscription of 40%. Total bids accepted amounted to Kshs. 1.21 Billion. The market weighted average rate was 8.825%, and the weighted average of accepted bids which will be applied for non-competitive bids was 8.825% down from 8.847% in the previous auction. The other auction statistics are summarised in the table below.

The actual amount to be realised from the auction will be subject to Treasury's immediate liquidity requirements for the week. Where several successful bidders quote a common rate, the Central Bank of Kenya reserves the right to allot bids on a pro-rata basis. The Central Bank reserves the right to accept/reject bids in part or in full without giving any reason. Individual bids must be of a minimum face value of Kshs. 100,000.00. Only CDS holders with updated mandates are eligible.

Bids must be submitted using the specified format and must reach the Central Bank (HQ, Branch or Currency Centre) by 2.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 16th April, 2014 for 182-day and 364-day, and Thursday, 17th April 2014 for 91-day Treasury Bills. Payments above Kshs.1 Million must be made by electronic transfer using RTGS. Payments below Kshs.1 Million may be made by Cash, Banker's Cheque or RTGS. These payments must reach the Central Bank not later than Monday, 21st April 2014, 2.00 p.m. for Cash and Cheques and 3.00 p.m for RTGS electronic fund transfers. Please provide the following details with each payment: Name, Reference No., the New CDS Portfolio and the customer's Virtual account No.

All documentation required for rollovers should be duly submitted by the Wednesday preceding the value date.

D. NON-COMPETITIVE BIDS

Non-competitive bids are subject to a maximum of Kshs. 20 Million per investor and are issued at the weighted average of accepted bids.
