

A. RESULTS OF 91 DAYS TREASURY BILLS ISSUE NO. 2191 VALUE DATED 19/12/2016

This week the Central Bank of Kenya offered 91-day Treasury Bills for a total of Kshs.4 Billion. The total number of bids received was 143 amounting to Kshs 2.589 Billion, representing a subscription of 64.72%. Total bids accepted amounted to Kshs. 2.589 Billion. The market weighted average rate was 8.484% and the weighted average of accepted bids which will be applied for non-competitive bids was 8.484% up from 8.359% in the previous auction. The other auction statistics are summarised in the table below.

Where several successful bidders quote a common rate, the Central Bank of Kenya reserves the right to allot bids on a pro-rata basis. The Central Bank reserves the right to accept/reject bids in part or in full without giving any reason. Individual bids must be of a minimum face value of Kshs. 100,000.00. Only investors with active CDS accounts are eligible.

Bids must be submitted and received by CBK either manually (application forms delivered in Treasury Bill tender boxes in any Branch or Currency Centre of Central Bank of Kenya or electronically (via CBK Internet Banking platform for commercial Banks) by 2.00 p.m. on **Wednesday, 21st December, 2016** for 182 & 364 days Treasury Bills and **Thursday 22nd December** for 91 days Treasury Bill. Payments above Kshs.1 Million must be made by electronic transfer using RTGS. Payments below Kshs.1 Million may be made by Cash, Banker's Cheque or RTGS. These payments must reach the Central Bank not later than **Tuesday, 27th December 2016**, 2.00 p.m. for Cash and Cheques and 3.00 p.m for RTGS electronic fund transfers. Please provide the following details with each payment: Name, Reference No., CDS Portfolio No. and the customer's Virtual account No.

D. Non-competitive bids are subject to a maximum of Kshs. 20 Million per investor and are issued at the weighted average of accepted bids.
