## **Commentary on Remittances, October 2016**

The Central Bank of Kenya conducts a survey on remittance inflows every month through formal channels that include commercial banks and other authorized international remittance service providers in Kenya.

Remittance inflows to Kenya increased by 3.9 percent to USD 142.6 million in October 2016 from USD 137.1 million in October 2015, but declined by 0.4 percent when compared to September 2016 (Table 1) largely reflecting lower inflows from the rest of the world (Table 2).

The 12-month cumulative inflows to October 2016 increased by 10.3 percent to USD 1,684 million from USD 1,527 million during a similar period in2015. The 12 month average flow also sustained an upward trend to USD 140.4 million from USD 127.3 million during the same period (Chart 1). Remittances as a share of GDP, increased to 2.5 percent over the twelve months to October 2016 from 2.4 percent in the year to October 2015.

## Remittance inflows by source market

Remittance inflows from North America accounted for 52 percent of total inflows and increased by 2.2 percent to USD 74.2 million in October 2016, while Inflows from Europe accounted for 29.5 percent of total inflows and declined marginally by 0.3 percent. Inflows from the rest of the world also declined by 7.4 percent to USD 26.3 million from USD 28.4 million (Table 2).
