The Central Bank of Kenya (CBK) welcomes Mr. Gerald Nyaoma Arita, as he begins his term as Deputy Governor. This follows his appointment by His Excellency President William Samoei Ruto, PhD., C.G.H.

Mr. Nyaoma returns to CBK after having had a long and distinguished career at the Bank. He joined CBK in August 1988, and served in various senior positions including the Financial Markets, Banking Services, and Internal Audit Departments, culminating in his role as the Director of the Bank Supervision Department.

Mr. Nyaoma holds an M. Phil. (Econ.) degree from the University of Cambridge, UK, and BA (Economics) degree from the University of Nairobi. Mr. Nyaoma is a Certified Public Accountant (CPA-K), a Certified Public Secretary (CPS-K) and an Associate of the Kenya Institute of Bankers (AKIB). He has served on the Board of the SACCO Societies Regulatory Authority as an Alternate Member to the Governor.
