

KEY MONETARY AND FINANCIAL INDICATORS

Exchange Rates

The Kenya Shilling remained relatively stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending September 10. It exchanged at KSh 108.40 per US dollar on September 10, compared to KSh 108.30 per US dollar on September 3 (Table 1).

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 8,877 million (5.39 months of import cover) as at September 10. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover, and the EAC region's convergence criteria of 4.5 months of import cover (Table 2).

Money Markets

The money market was relatively liquid during the week ending September 10, supported by government payments. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 34.7 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 2.62 percent on September 10 compared to 3.06 percent on September 3. The average number of interbank deals per day increased to 28 from 23 in the previous week, and the value traded increased to KSh 13.4 billion from KSh 11.0 billion in the previous week (Table 3).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auction of September 10 received bids totalling KSh 20.2 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 84.1 percent. Interest rates remained stable, with the 91-day Treasury bill rate declining slightly and those of the 182-day and 364-day Treasury bills rising marginally (Table 4).

Equity Market

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, the NSE 20 share price index rose by 1.1 percent, while the NASI and NSE 25 share price index decreased by 0.7 percent and 0.8 percent, respectively during the week ending September 10. The number of shares traded, equity turnover and market capitalization also decreased by 30.4 percent, 35.7 percent and 0.7 percent, respectively (Table 10).

Bond Market

Turnover of bonds traded in the domestic secondary market decreased by 20.9 percent during the week ending September 10 (Table 10). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds remained stable increasing by an average of 13.4 basis points. The yields on the 10-year Eurobonds for Angola and Ghana also remained stable (Chart 2).

Global Trends

International oil prices decreased during the week following a buildup in inventory attributed to subdued demand. Murban oil price declined to USD 39.95 per barrel on September 10 from USD 43.81 per barrel on September 3.

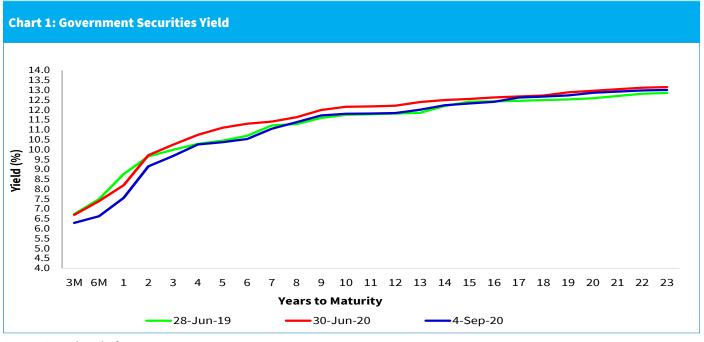

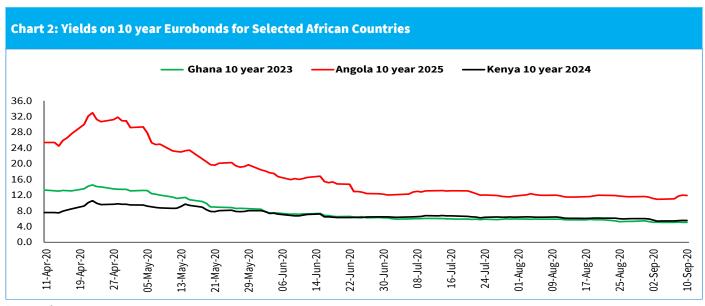
