KEY MONETARY AND FINANCIAL INDICATORS

Exchange Rate

The Kenya Shilling strengthened against major international and regional currencies during the week ending November 14, amid capital inflows. It exchanged at KSh 102.10 per US Dollar on November 14, compared to KSh 102.95 on November 7 (Table 1).

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The CBK usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 8,943 million (5.59 months of import cover) as at November 14. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavour to maintain at least 4 months of imports cover, and the EAC region's convergence criteria of 4.5 months of import cover (Table 2).

Money Market

The money market was liquid during the week ending November 14, largely due to government payments. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 14.5 billion in relation to the 5.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). The open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate decreased to 2.97 percent on November 14 from 4.55 percent on November 7. The average number of interbank deals per day increased to 16 from 14, while the value traded increased to KSh 13.1 billion from KSh 8.7 billion (Table 3).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auctions of November 14 received bids totaling KSh 13.8 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 57.7 percent. Interest rates on the 91-day and 182-day Treasury bills increased, while 364-day Treasury bill rate declined marginally (Table 4).

Equity Market

The NASI, NSE 25 and NSE 20-share price indices declined by 4.1 percent, 4.3 percent and 4.1 percent, respectively during the week ending November 14. Similarly, market capitalization, equity turnover and total shares traded decreased by 4.1 percent, 66.7 percent and 64.0 percent, respectively (Table 6).

Bond Market

Turnover of bonds in the domestic secondary market increased by 2.7 percent during the week ending November 14. In the international market, yields on Kenya's 10-year (2024), 10-year (2028), 12-year and 30-year Eurobonds increased by 4.0, 13.1, 13.8 and 10.1 basis points, respectively. However, the yield on 7-year Eurobond declined by 0.3 basis points (Table 6). The yield on 10-year Eurobonds for Angola and Ghana increased (Chart 2).

Global Trends

Trade tensions eased during the week due to the news of possible trade agreement between USA and China. However, threats by USA to increase tariffs on Chinese goods if China does not accept phase one of the trade agreement, and a directive from the UK Home Office requiring EU citizens to apply for new immigration status before the January 31 Brexit deadline, have maintained uncertainty in major financial markets.

International oil prices increased during the week due to supply-demand imbalance and the heightened Hong Kong street protests. The Murban oil prices rose from USD 62.93 per barrel on November 7 to USD 64.76 per barrel on November 14.




