KEY MONETARY AND FINANCIAL INDICATORS

Exchange Rates

The Kenya Shilling remained stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending July 9. It exchanged at KSh 106.96 per US dollar on July 9 compared to KSh 106.54 per US dollar on July 2 (Table 1).

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 9,704 million (5.83 months of import cover) as at July 9. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover, and the EAC region's convergence criteria of 4.5 months of import cover (Table 2).

Money Markets

The money market was liquid during the week ending July 9, supported by government payments, which offset tax receipts. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 29.8 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 2.36 percent on July 9 compared to 2.25 percent on July 2. The average number of interbank deals per day declined to 6 from 11 in the previous week, and the value traded also declined to KSh 4.5 billion from KSh 5.3 billion in the previous week (Table 3).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auction of July 9 received bids totalling KSh 86.0 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 358.2 percent. Interest rates on all the Treasury bills tenors decreased (Table 4).

Equity Market

The number of shares traded and equity turnover at the Nairobi Securities Exchange increased by 95.8 percent and 113.8 percent, respectively, during the week ending July 9. However, the NASI, NSE 25 and NSE 20 share price indices declined by 3.8 percent, 3.2 percent and 1.9 percent, respectively. Market capitalization also declined by 3.8 percent (Table 5).

Bond Market

Turnover of bonds traded in the domestic secondary market increased by 10.9 percent during the week ending July 9 (Table 5). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds remained stable, rising marginally by an average of 0.14 basis points. Similarly, the yields on the 10-year Eurobonds for Angola and Ghana increased marginally (Chart 2).

Global Trends

The global financial markets sentiment during the week was dominated by COVID-19 anxiety as several countries grappled with rapid increases in new infections. This dampened the impact of positive economic data in some advanced and emerging market economies.

International oil prices increased during the week reflecting mild pickup in demand in Europe and China. Murban oil price increased to USD 43.93 per barrel on July 9 from USD 42.91 per barrel on July 2.




