# RECENT MONETARY AND FINANCIAL DEVELOPMENTS

## **Exchange Rates**

The Kenya Shilling remained stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending December 8. It exchanged at KSh 122.74 per US dollar on December 8, compared to KSh 122.50 per US dollar on December 1 (**Table 1**).

## **Foreign Exchange Reserves**

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 7,103 million (3.98 months of import cover) as at December 8. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover (Table 2).

#### **Remittances**

Remittance inflows remained strong at USD 345.5 million in November compared to USD 332.6 million in October, an increase of 3.9 percent (**Chart 1**). The cumulative inflows for the 12 months to November totaled USD 4,021 million compared to USD 3,667 million in November 2021, an increase of 9.7 percent. The remittance inflows continue to support the current account and the foreign exchange market. The US remains the largest source of remittances into Kenya, accounting for 55.8 percent in November.

#### **Money Market**

Liquidity in the money market improved during the week ending December 8, as government payments more than offset tax remittances. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 14.5 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 5.19 percent on December 8 compared to 5.08 percent on December 1. The average number of interbank deals decreased to 24 from 33 in the previous week, while the average value traded decreased to KSh 19.1 billion from KSh 22.1 billion (**Table 3**).

## **Government Securities Market**

The Treasury bill auction of December 8, received bids totalling KSh 23.3 billion against an advertised amount of

KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 97.1 percent. Interest rates remained stable, with 91-day, 182-day and 364-day rates increasing marginally **(Table 4).** 

During the Treasury bond auction of December 7, the re-opened 20-year and 25-year fixed rate Treasury bonds received bids totaling KSh 30.6 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 40 billion, representing a performance rate of 76.4 percent **(Table 5).** 

### **Equity Market**

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, the NASI and NSE 25 declined by 0.4 percent and 0.1 percent, respectively, while NSE 20 increased by 0.2 percent during the week ending December 8. Market capitalization, declined by 0.4 percent, while equity turnover and total shares traded increased by 3.4 percent and 13.1 percent, respectively **(Table 6).** 

# **Bonds Market**

Bond turnover in the domestic secondary market increased by 23.2 percent during the week ending December 8 (**Table 6**). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds increased by an average of 12.87 basis points, with 2024 maturity increasing by 73.2 basis points. The yield on the 10-Year Eurobonds for Ghana and Angola also increased (**Chart 3**).

#### **Global Trends**


Concerns about inflation in advanced economies remained during the week ending December 8. The Bank of Canada increased its interest rate by 50 basis points. The index of the US dollar against a basket of major currencies strengthened by 0.04 percent during the week ending December 8.

International oil prices declined during the week ending December 8 amid concerns over weakening global growth. Murban oil price decreased to USD 76.13 per barrel on December 8 from USD 85.86 per barrel on December 1.




