

Weekly Statistical Bulletin

Key Monetary and Financial Indicators



Interbank Market

Trading in the interbank market decreased during the week ending June 13, 2018, partly reflecting relatively improved banks' liquidity position. The volumes traded decreased to an average of KSh 14.4 billion from KSh 21.8 billion in the previous week while the number of deals decreased to an average of 24 from an average of 29. Similarly, the weighted average interbank rate decreased to 3.59 percent from 4.10 percent in the previous week (**Table 1**).

Exchange Rate

The Kenya Shilling remained stable against the USD Dollar and the Sterling Pound and, strengthened against the Japanese Yen during the week ending June 14, 2018. It, however, weakened against the Euro. In the EAC region, the Kenya Shilling strengthened against the Uganda Shilling and remained stable against the Tanzania shilling, Rwanda Franc, and the Burundi Franc (**Table 2**).

Equity Market

The equity market recorded mixed performance in the 4 trading days ending June 13, 2018. Overall equity prices increased as reflected by gains in NASI, despite the decine in NSE 25 and NSE 20 share indices. The volume and number of shares traded declined, reflecting shorter trading week. Shareholders' wealth, measured by market capitalization, rose by 0.67 percent as a result of the overall share gain (Table 3).

Bond Market

The volume of bonds traded rose by 12.39 percent in the week ending June 13, 2018, compared to the previous week. This improvement reflects continued appetite for fixed income assests (Table 3).

The yields on Kenyan Eurobonds increased across all the four tranches compared to the previous week. This reflects the general trend in the international bond market. Compared to 10-year Eurobonds issued by select African countries, the yield on Kenya's 10 year Eurobond remains lower and stable (Chart 1).




