March 23, 2018

Activity in the Interbank Market

The volumes traded in the interbank market eased to an average of KSh 15.2 billion during the week ending March 21, 2018 from KSh 16.8 billion the previous week. Banks therefore began the new Cash Reserve Requirement Cycle (March 15 - April 14, 2018) with ample liquidity. The number of deals in the interbank market remained stable at an average of 32. The weighted average interbank rate increased marginally to 4.57 percent from 4.32 percent in the previous week, partly reflecting the seasonal pickup in demand for funds around the 20th of every month to facilitate VAT tax remittances (**Table 1**).

Kenya Shilling Exchange Rate

The Kenya Shilling remained steady against major international currencies during the week ending March 22, 2018. The Shilling remained stable against the US Dollar supported by low interbank activity. It strengthened against the Euro and weakened against the Japanese Yen and the Sterling Pound. In the EAC region the Shilling strengthened against all the currencies (Table 2).

Equity Market

The equity market recorded gains across all the leading indicators for the week ending March 22, 2018.

Prices in the equities market improved by 4.8 percent, 4.9 percent and 2.2 percent for NASI, NSE 25 and the NSE 20 share indices respectively. The number of shares traded rose by 52.2 percent, triggering an increase of 64.1 percent in equity turnover. As a result, shareholder wealth, as measured by market capitalization rose by KSh 129.72 billion or 4.8 percent (**Table 3**). The vibrancy in the market may be on account of increased investor interest following reduction of the Central Bank Rate (CBR).

Bond Market and Eurobond Yields

Turnover in the bond market reduced by KSh 5,134 million, or 36.2 percent in the week ending March 22, 2018. This may be attributed to investors' focus on primary market auction of the FXD1/2018/5 and FXD1/2018/20 Treasury Bonds during the week, that attracted 128.5 percent subscription rate against the KSh 40 billion offered. The yields on Kenya's 5-year, 10-year (2024), 10-year (2028) and 30-year Eurobonds decreased slightly during the week, signalling an increase in bond prices (**Table 3**).

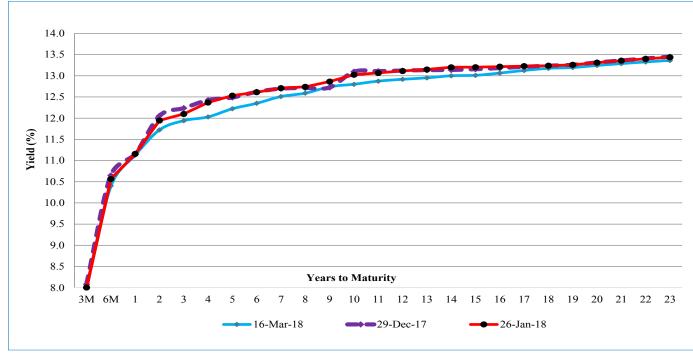
