RECENT MONETARY AND FINANCIAL DEVELOPMENTS

Exchange Rates

The Kenya Shilling remained relatively stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending October 26. It exchanged at KSh 150.27 per US dollar on October 26, compared to KSh 149.79 per US dollar on October 19 (**Table 1**).

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 6,836 million (3.67 months of import cover) as at October 26. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover (Table 2).

Money Market

Liquidity in the money market decreased during the week ending October 26. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 19.8 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 12.51 percent on October 26 compared to 12.62 percent on October 19. During the week, the average number of interbank deals decreased to 24 from 31 in the previous week, while the average value traded decreased to KSh 14.5 billion from KSh 20.2 billion in the previous week (Table 3).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auction of October 26 received bids totaling KSh 18.2 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 75.6 percent. Interest rates remained stable, with the 91-day, 182-day and 364-day rates increasing marginally **(Table 4).**

Equity Market

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, the NASI, NSE 25 and NSE 20 share price indices declined by 3.6 percent, 1.8 percent and 1.3 percent, respectively during the week ending October 26. Market capitalization, equity turnover and total shares traded also declined by 3.6 percent, 28.3 percent and 16.7 percent, respectively (**Table 6**).

Bond Market

Bond turnover in the domestic secondary market declined by 27.7 percent during the week ending October 26 (**Table 7**). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds declined by an average of 76.1 basis points, with the 2024 maturity declining by 146.60 basis points. The yield on the 10- Year Eurobond for Angola also declined while that of Zambia increased (**Chart 2**).

Global Trends

Inflation in advanced economies has continued to moderate. The European Central Bank (ECB) maintained its policy rate at 4.0 percent after 10 consecutives hikes. The US economy remained strong in the third quarter of 2023, growing by 4.9 percent. The US dollar index strengthened by 0.3 percent against a basket of major currencies during the week ending October 26.

International oil prices decreased during the week ending October 26, as concerns of a wider Middle East conflict eased. Murban oil price dropped to USD 90.23 per barrel on October 26 from USD 93.11 per barrel on October 19.

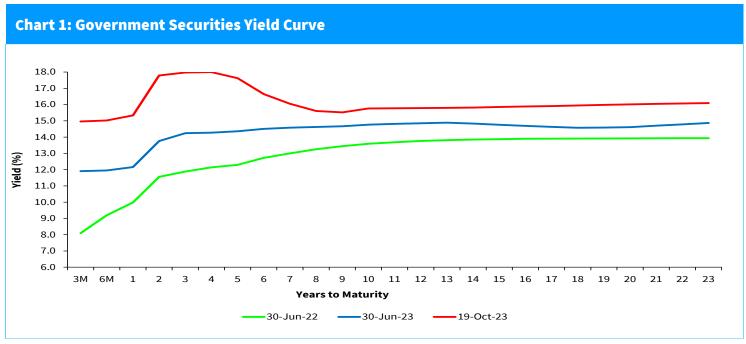

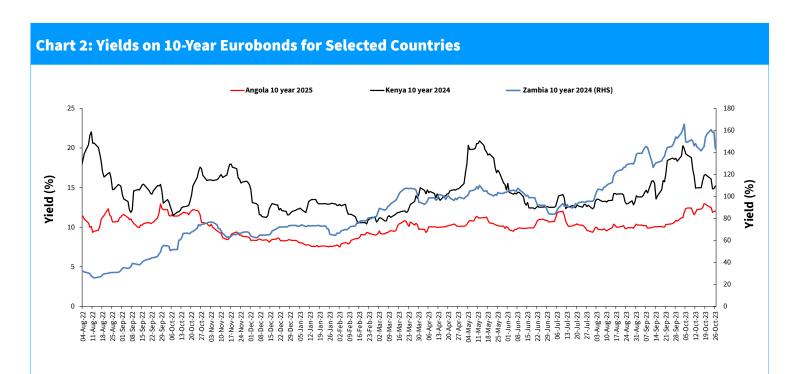
