## **KEY MONETARY AND FINANCIAL INDICATORS**

# **Exchange Rate**

The Kenya Shilling remained stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending June 11. It exchanged at KSh 106.60 per US dollar on June 11 compared to KSh 106.12 per US dollar on June 4 (Table 1).

# **Foreign Exchange Reserves**

The CBK usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 9,302 million (5.59 months of import cover) as at June 11. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavour to maintain at least 4 months of import cover, and the EAC region's convergence criteria of 4.5 months of import cover (Table 2).

# **Money Markets**

The money market was liquid during the week ending June 11, supported by government payments. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 32.8 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate declined to 2.59 percent on June 11 from 3.12 percent on June 4. The average number of interbank deals per day decreased to 10 from 21 in the previous week, while the value traded decreased to KSh 4.0 billion from KSh 12.3 billion in the previous week (Table 3).

### **Government Securities**

The Treasury bills auction of June 11 received bids totalling KSh 69.7 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 290.5 percent. Interest rates on all the Treasury bills tenors decreased (Table 4).

### **Equity Market**

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, the NASI, NSE 20 and the NSE 25 share price indies increased by 2.3 percent, 3.3 percent and 2.1 percent, respectively, during the week ending June 11. Market capitalization, equity turnover and the number of shares traded also increased by 2.3 percent, 16.0 percent and 36.2 percent, respectively (Table 6).

#### **Bonds Market**

Turnover of bonds traded in the domestic secondary market declined by 7.9 percent during the week (Table 6). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds declined by an average of 9.94 basis points. The yields on the 10-year Eurobonds for Angola and Ghana also declined (Chart 2).

#### **Global Trends**

Global financial markets activity remained subdued during the week as the recent investor optimism arising from reopening of economies was dampened by OECD's forecast of a 6 percent contraction of global economy in 2020.

International oil prices increased during the week supported by OPEC's decision to maintain production cuts and the continued optimism about recovery in global demand. Murban oil price increased to USD 41.25 per barrel on June 11 from USD 39.14 per barrel on June 4.




