

# **KEY MONETARY AND FINANCIAL INDICATORS (REVISED)**

# **Exchange Rates**

The Kenya Shilling weakened marginally against major international and regional currencies during the week ending August 13. It exchanged at KSh 108.39 per US dollar on August 13, compared to KSh 107.95 per US dollar on August 6 (Table 1).

## **Foreign Exchange Reserves**

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 9,249 million (5.6 months of import cover) as at August 13. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover, and the EAC region's convergence criteria of 4.5 months of import cover (Table 2).

# **Money Markets**

The money market remained liquid during the week ending August 13, supported by government payments, which offset tax receipts. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 19.7 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate declined to 1.76 percent on August 13 from 2.34 percent on August 6. The average number of interbank deals per day increased to 20 from 18 in the previous week, and the value traded increased to KSh 14.5 billion from KSh 10.3 billion in the previous week (Table 3).

#### **Government Securities Market**

The Treasury bills auction of August 13 received bids totalling KSh 22.3 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 92.8 percent. Interest rates on the Treasury bills increased marginally (Table 4).

### **Equity Market**

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, both NASI and market capitalization rose by 0.1 percent during the week ending August 13. However, the number of shares traded, equity turnover and NSE 20 share price index declined by 47.6 percent, 43.9 percent and 1.2 percent, respectively (Table 6).

#### **Bond Market**

Turnover of bonds traded in the domestic secondary market rose by 39.6 percent during the week ending August 13 (Table 6). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds declined by an average of 41.9 basis points. The yields on the 10-year Eurobonds for Ghana and Angola also declined (Chart 2).

#### **Global Trends**

Global financial markets sentiment was muted during the week as investors remained cautious following a stand off amongst the U.S lawmakers about the next stimulus package and the U.K's sharp contraction in output by a record 20.4 percent in Q2.

International oil prices increased marginally during the week on account of a historic peace deal between Israel and the UAE. Murban oil price rose to 44.41 per barrel on August 13 from USD 44.05 per barrel on August 6.




