



RECENT MONETARY AND FINANCIAL DEVELOPMENTS

Exchange Rates

The Kenya Shilling remained relatively stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending October 12. It exchanged at KSh 149.01 per US dollar on October 12, compared to KSh 148.56 per US dollar on October 5 (**Table 1**).

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 6,872 million (3.69 months of import cover) as at October 12. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover (Table 2).

Money Market

Liquidity in the money market decreased during the week ending October 12. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 17.5 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 12.16 percent on October 12, compared to 11.93 percent on October 5. During the week, the average number of interbank deals increased to 49 from 37 in the previous week, while the average value traded increased to KSh 32.1 billion from KSh 24.1 billion in the previous week (Table 3).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auction of October 12 received bids totaling KSh 43.2 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 180.2 percent. Interest rates remained stable, with the 91-day, 182-day and 364-day rates increasing marginally (**Table 4**).

During the week under review, the re-opened 2-year and 5-year fixed rate Treasury bonds auction of October 11 received bids totaling KSh 12.3 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 35 billion, representing a performance of 35.4 percent **(Table 5).**

Equity Market

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, the NASI, NSE 25 and NSE 20 share price indices declined by 1.5 percent, 0.9 percent and 0.5 percent, respectively, during the week ending October 12. Market capitalization declined by 1.5 percent, while equity turnover and total shares traded increased by 140.5 percent and 112.2 percent, respectively (**Table 6**).

Bond Market

Bond turnover in the domestic secondary market declined by 84.1 percent during the week ending October 12 (**Table 6**). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds declined by an average of 137.2 basis points, with the 2024 maturity declining by 434.9 basis points. The yields on the 10- Year Eurobonds for Zambia and Angola also declined (**Chart 2**).

Global Trends

Inflation concerns in advanced economies continue to moderate. The US annual inflation remained steady at 3.7 percent in September, same as the previous month. The UK economy grew by 0.2 percent in August from a contraction of 0.6 percent in July. The US dollar index strengthened by 0.3 percent against a basket of major currencies during the week ending October 12.

International oil prices increased during the week ending October 12, attributed to war between Israel and Hamas group in Palestine. Murban oil price rose to USD 89.01 per barrel on October 12 from USD 87.83 per barrel on October 5.

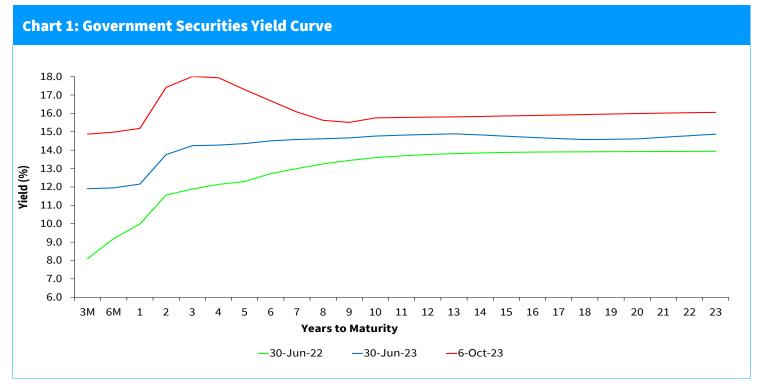

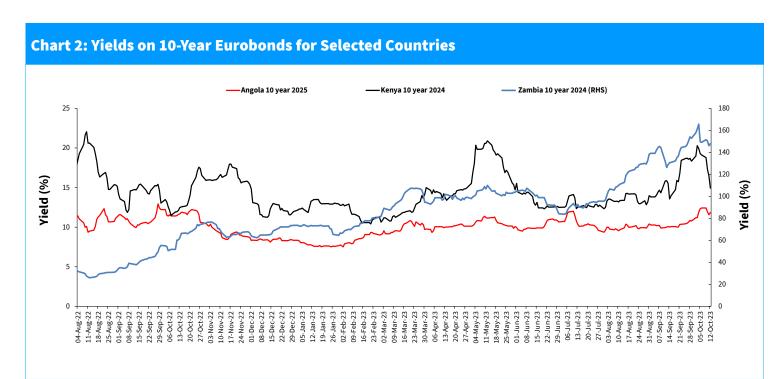
