



RECENT MONETARY AND FINANCIAL DEVELOPMENTS

Exchange Rates

The Kenya Shilling remained relatively stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending July 13. It exchanged at KSh 141.29 per US dollar on July 13, compared to KSh 140.78 per US dollar on July 6 **(Table 1).**

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 7,481 million (4.09 months of import cover) as at July 13. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover (Table 2).

Remittances

Remittance inflows in June 2023 totaled USD 345.9 million compared to USD 326.1 million in June 2022, an increase of 6.1 percent **(Chart 1).** The cumulative inflows for the 12 months to June remained steady at USD 4,017 million compared to USD 4,012 million in a similar period in 2022, an increase of 0.1 percent. The remittance inflows continue to support the current account and the foreign exchange market. The US remains the largest source of remittances to Kenya, accounting for 54 percent in June 2023.

Money Market

Liquidity in the money market increased during the week ending July 13, supported by government payments. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 28.3 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 8.57 percent on July 13 compared to 9.53 percent on July 6. During the week, the average number of interbank deals declined to 25 from 34 in the previous week, while the average value traded declined slightly to KSh 14.3 billion from KSh 14.9 billion in the previous week (**Table 3**).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auction of July 13, received bids totaling KSh 36.4 billion against an advertised amount of KSh

24.0 billion, representing a performance of 151.8 percent. Interest rates remained stable, with 91-day, 182-day and 364-day rates increasing marginally **(Table 4).**

During the Treasury bonds auction of July 12, the reopened 10-year fixed rate Treasury bond and the new 5-year fixed rate Treasury bond received bids totaling KSh 51.8 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 40 billion, representing a performance rate of 129.4 percent **(Table 5).**

Equity Market

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, the NASI, NSE 25 and NSE 20 share price indices increased by 5.0 percent, 3.7 percent and 0.9 percent, respectively, during the week ending July 13. Market capitalisation increased by 5.0 percent. However, equity turnover and total shares traded declined by 21.6 percent and 36.0 percent, respectively (Table 6).

Bond Market

Bond turnover in the domestic secondary market increased by 14.5 percent during the week ending July 13 **(Table 6).** In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds remained stable increasing by a marginal of 0.42 basis points. The yield on 2024 maturity declined by 78.60 basis points. The yield on the 10- Year Eurobond for Ghana increased, while that of Angola declined **(Chart 3).**

Global Trends

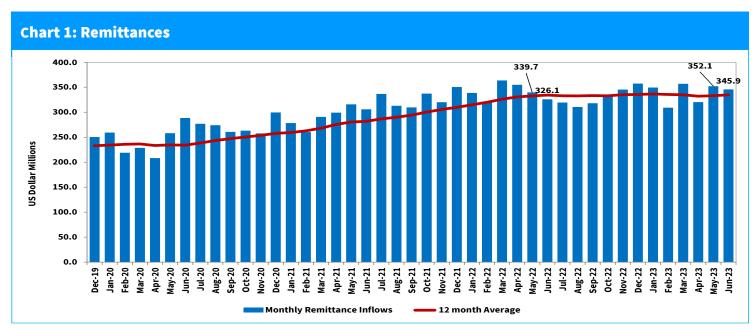
Inflation concerns in advanced economies continue to moderate. U.S inflation declined to 3.0 percent in June compared to 4.0 percent in May. The US dollar index weakened by 3.2 percent against a basket of major currencies during the week ending July 13.

International oil prices increased during the week ending July 13, mainly due to concerns over reduced global oil supply by major oil exporters. Murban oil price rose to USD 81.31 on July 13 from USD 77.66 per barrel on July 6.

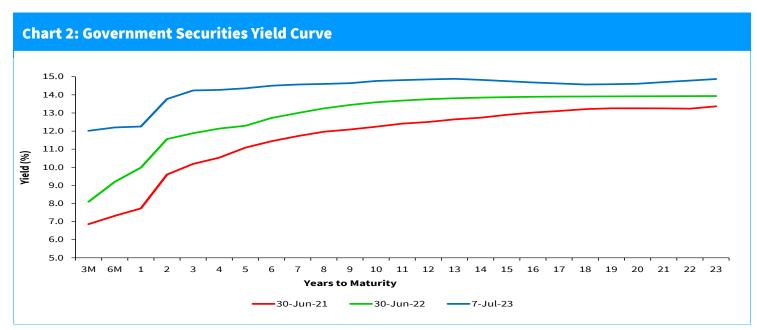

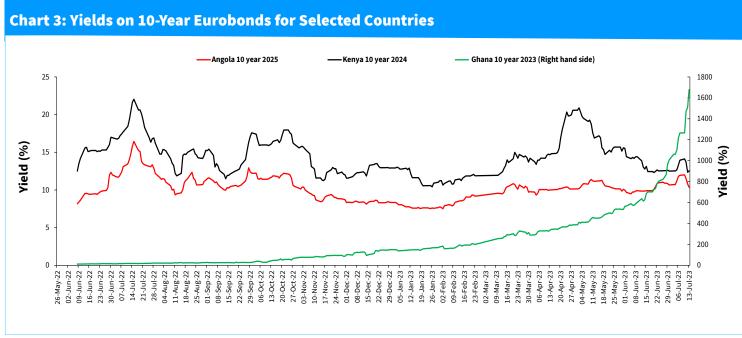
