

KEY MONETARY AND FINANCIAL INDICATORS

Inflation

Overall inflation edged up to 4.8 percent in October 2020 from 4.2 percent in September, partly driven by increases in prices of a few food items and cost of transport (Chart 1).

Exchange Rates

The Kenya Shilling remained stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending October 29. It exchanged at KSh 108.83 per US dollar on October 29, compared to KSh 108.75 per US dollar on October 22 (Table 1).

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 8,121 million (4.93 months of import cover) as at October 29. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavour to maintain at least 4 months of import cover, and the EAC region's convergence criteria of 4.5 months of import cover (Table 2).

Current Account

Provisional data on balance of payments shows that the current account deficit narrowed to 5.0 percent of GDP in the 12 months to September 2020 compared to 5.4 percent of GDP during a similar period in 2019 (Chart 2). This reflected lower oil imports and strong performance of exports, particularly tea, as well as resilient remittances.

Money Markets

The money market was relatively liquid during the week ending October 29, supported by government payments, which offset tax receipts. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 9.5 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 3.1 percent on October 29 compared to 2.62 percent on October 22. The average number of interbank deals per day increased to 29 from 25 in the previous week, while the average value traded declined to KSh 13.7 billion from KSh 17.4 billion in the previous week (Table 3).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auction of October 29 received bids totalling KSh 17.3 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 72.1 percent. Interest rates on all the Treasury bills tenors remained stable (Table 4).

Equity Market

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE), equity turnover and total number of shares traded rose by 153.5 percent and 131.6 percent, respectively during the week ending October 29. However, NASI, NSE 25 and NSE 20 share price indices declined by 0.8 percent, 1.2 percent and 0.3 percent, respectively. Similarly, market capitalization declined by 0.8 percent (Table 6).

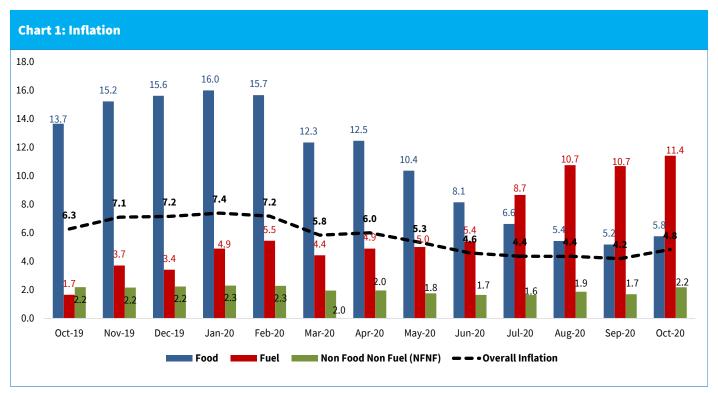
Bond Market

Turnover of bonds traded in the domestic secondary market rose by 5.6 percent during the week ending October 29 (Table 6). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds declined by an average of 26.4 basis points. However, the yields on the 10-year Eurobonds for Angola and Ghana rose towards the end of the week (Chart 4).

Global Trends

Global financial markets sentiment during the week ending October 30 was dampened by the diminishing prospects of a pre-election fiscal stimulus in the US and the resurgence in coronavirus infections in the US and Europe. However, the US economy performed better than expected, growing at an annualized rate of 33.1 percent in the third quarter of 2020.

International oil prices declined during the week reflecting subdued global demand. Murban oil price decreased to USD 38.87 per barrel on October 29 from USD 42.09 per barrel on October 22.

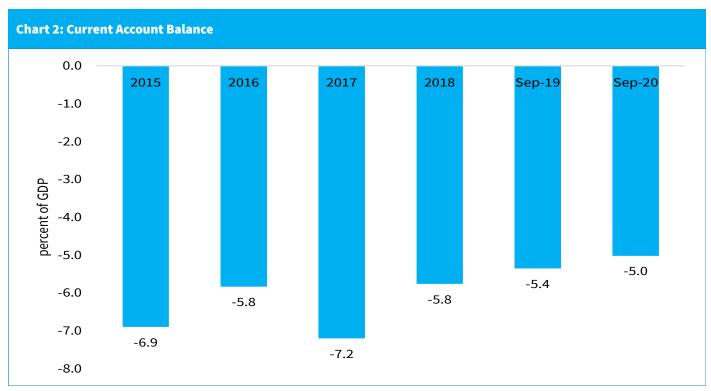

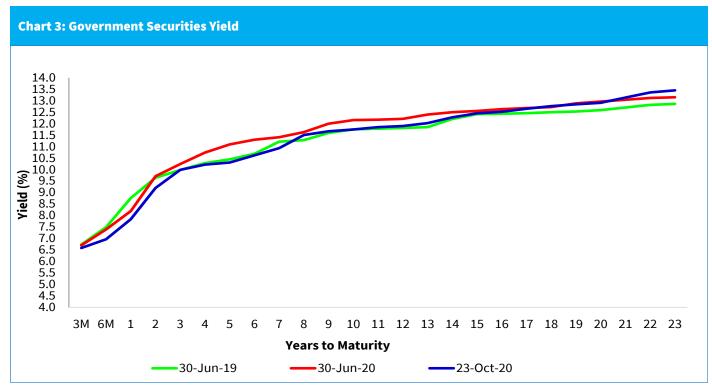

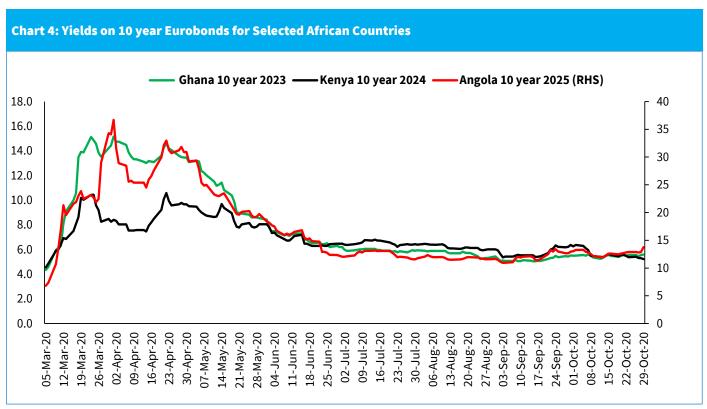
