RECENT MONETARY AND FINANCIAL DEVELOPMENTS

Exchange Rates

The Kenya Shilling remained relatively stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending December 14. It exchanged at KSh 153.37 per US dollar on December 14, compared to KSh 153.32 per US dollar on December 7 (Table 1).

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 6,711 million (3.59 months of import cover) as at December 14. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover (Table 2).

Money Market

Liquidity in the money market decreased during the week ending December 14. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 17.9 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 11.26 percent on December 14 compared to 10.33 percent on December 7. During the week, the average number of interbank deals increased to 49 from 27 in the previous week, while the average value traded increased to KSh 29.0 billion from KSh 20.5 billion in the previous week (Table 3).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auction of December 14 received bids totaling KSh 17.3 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 72.3 percent. Interest rates remained stable, with the 91-day, 182-day and 364-day rates increasing marginally (Table 4).

Equity Market

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, the NASI, NSE 25 and NSE 20 share price indices decreased by 0.9 percent, 1.2 percent and 0.5 percent, respectively during the week ending December 14. Market capitalization, equity turnover and total shares traded declined by 0.9 percent, 63.7 percent and 61.4 percent, respectively (Table 6).

Bond Market

Bond turnover in the domestic secondary market increased by 52.7 percent during the week ending December 14 (Table 6). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds declined by an average of 69.1 basis points, with the 2024 maturity declining by 51.5 basis points. The yield on the 10- year Eurobond for Angola declined while that of Zambia increased (Chart 2).

Global Trends

Inflation in advanced economies continue to moderate, with the US annual inflation falling to 3.1 percent in November from 3.2 percent in October. The US Federal Reserve held its benchmark interest rates during its December meeting at a target range of 5.25% - 5.5%. The US dollar index weakened by 1.53 percent against a basket of major currencies during the week ending December 14.

International oil prices decreased marginally during the week ending December 14, on account of weak oil demand and build-up of oil inventories. Murban oil price declined marginally to USD 75.13 per barrel on December 14 from USD 75.18 per barrel on December 7.

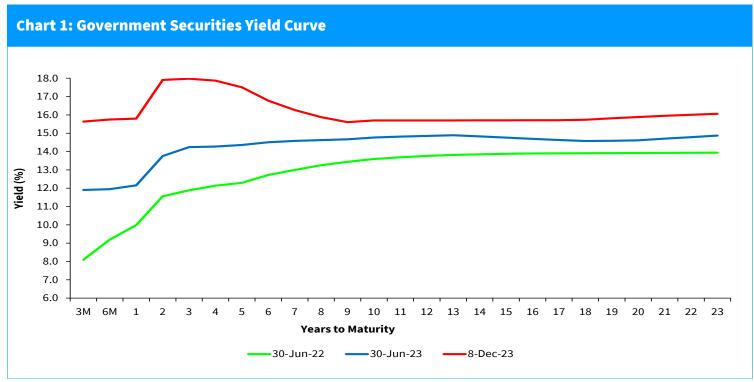

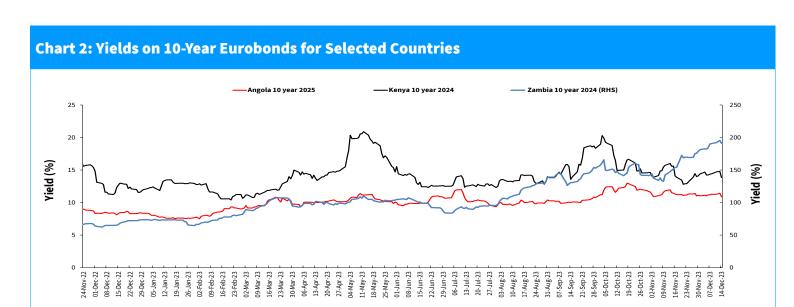
