KEY MONETARY AND FINANCIAL INDICATORS

Exchange Rates

The Kenya Shilling weakened against major international and regional currencies during the week ending July 16, on account of unevenly matched demand and supply of dollars in the interbank market. It exchanged at KSh 107.35 per US dollar on July 16 compared to KSh 106.96 per US dollar on July 9(Table 1).

Foreign Exchange Reserves

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 9,699 million (5.87 months of import cover) as at July 16. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavor to maintain at least 4 months of import cover, and the EAC region's convergence criteria of 4.5 months of import cover (Table 2).

Money Markets

The money market remained liquid during the week ending July 16, supported by government payments, which offset tax receipts. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 10.9 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 1.76 percent on July 16 compared to 2.36 percent on July 9. The average number of interbank deals per day increased to 13 from 6 in the previous week, and the value traded increased to KSh 8.4 billion from KSh 4.5 in the previous week (Table 3).

Government Securities Market

The Treasury bills auction of July 16 received bids totalling KSh 65.2 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 271.5 percent. Interest rates on all the Treasury bills tenors decreased (Table 4).

Equity Market

The NSE 25 share price and the number of shares traded at the Nairobi Securities Exchange increased by 0.4 percent and 13.0 percent, respectively during the week ending July 16 (Table 5). However, the NASI and NSE 20 share price indices, market capitalization and equity turnover declined by 0.4 percent, 0.1 percent, 0.4 percent and 2.2 percent, respectively.

Bond Market

Turnover of bonds traded in the domestic secondary market declined by 24.2 percent during the week ending July 16 (Table 5). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds rose by an average of 12.4 basis points. Similarly, the yields on the 10-year Eurobonds for Angola increased, while that of Ghana declined (Chart 2).

Global Trends

Global financial markets volatility remained elevated during the week reflecting investors' concerns about a post-pandemic recovery, and increased US - China trade tensions.

International oil prices decreased marginally during the week amid concerns of a second wave of the pandemic. Murban oil price decreased to USD 43.88 per barrel on July 16 from USD 43.93 per barrel on July 9.




