# RECENT MONETARY AND FINANCIAL DEVELOPMENTS

## **Exchange Rates**

The Kenya Shilling remained stable against major international and regional currencies during the week ending December 9. It exchanged at KSh 112.86 per US dollar on December 9, compared to KSh 112.56 per US dollar on December 2 (Table 1).

# **Foreign Exchange Reserves**

The usable foreign exchange reserves remained adequate at USD 8,730 million (5.34 months of import cover) as at December 9. This meets the CBK's statutory requirement to endeavour to maintain at least 4 months of import cover, and the EAC region's convergence criteria of 4.5 months of import cover (**Table 2**).

#### **Remittances**

Remittance inflows totaled USD 320.1 million in November 2021 compared to USD 257.7 million in November 2020, a 24.2 percent increase (**Chart 1**). The inflows were lower by 5.1 percent in November compared to the USD 337.4 million in October in line with seasonal factors. The cumulative inflows for the 12 months to November totaled USD 3,667 million compared to USD 3,045 million in the same period in 2020, a 20.4 percent increase. The United States remains the largest source of remittances into Kenya, accounting for 67.3 percent in November.

## **Money Market**

The money market was liquid during the week ending December 9, supported by government payments. Commercial banks' excess reserves stood at KSh 14.2 billion in relation to the 4.25 percent cash reserves requirement (CRR). Open market operations remained active. The average interbank rate was 4.60 percent on December 9 compared to 5.23 percent on December 2. During the week, the average number of interbank deals per day decreased to 18 from 23 in the previous week, while the average value traded decreased to KSh 5.0 billion from KSh 7.1 billion in the previous week **(Table 3).** 

#### **Goverment Securities Market**

The Treasury bill auction of December 9 received bids totaling KSh 15.8 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 24.0 billion, representing a performance of 65.7 percent. Interest rates on the Treasury bills remained stable with only marginal increases (**Table 4**).

During the Treasury bond auction of December 8, the two re-opened ten year and twenty-year Treasury bonds issued received bids totalling KSh 41.2 billion against an advertised amount of KSh 40.0 billion, representing a performance rate of 102.9 percent **(Table 5).** 

# **Equity Market**

At the Nairobi Securities Exchange, NASI, NSE 25, NSE 20 share indices, total shares traded, equity turnover and market capitalization declined by 1.4 percent, 0.6 percent, 0.3 percent, 31.8 percent, 27.0 percent and 1.4 percent, respectively, during the week ending December 9 (Table 6).

#### **Bonds Market**

Bonds turnover in the domestic secondary market declined by 2.9 percent during the week ending December 9 (**Table 6**). In the international market, yields on Kenya's Eurobonds declined by an average of 13.3 basis points. Similarly, yields on the 10-year Eurobonds for Angola and Ghana declined (**Chart 3**).

## **Global Trends**

Global financial markets sentiment rebounded during the week ending December 9, as investors became less concerned about the COVID-19 Omicron variant. However, concerns about inflation in the advanced economies persist.

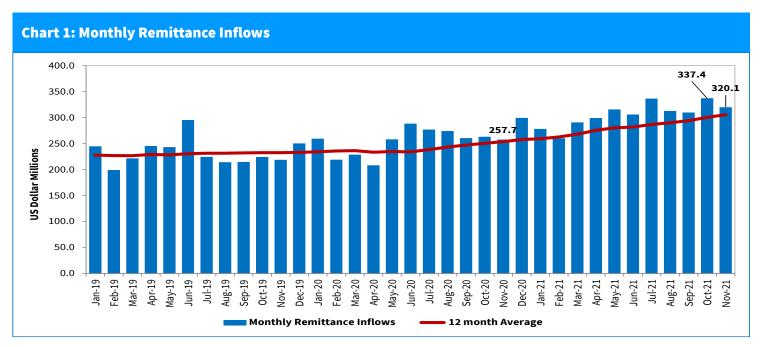
International oil prices increased during the week ending December 9, on account of demand and supply mismatch. Murban oil prices increased to USD 75.78 per barrel on December 9, compared to USD 70.07 per barrel on December 2.

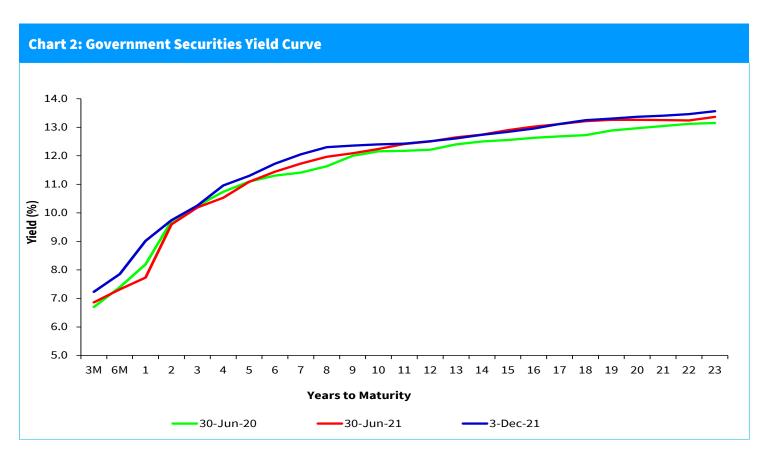

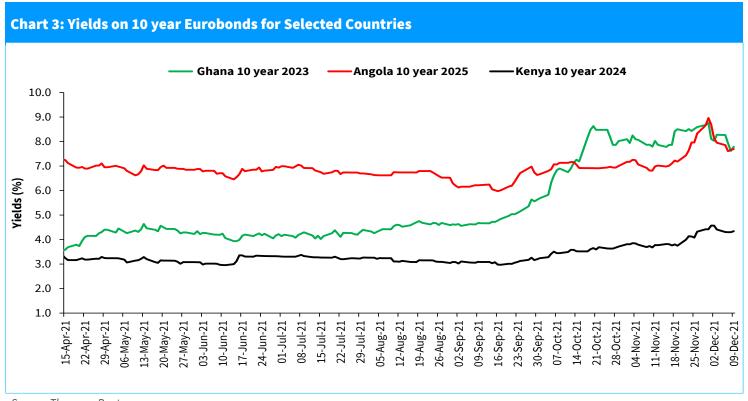
